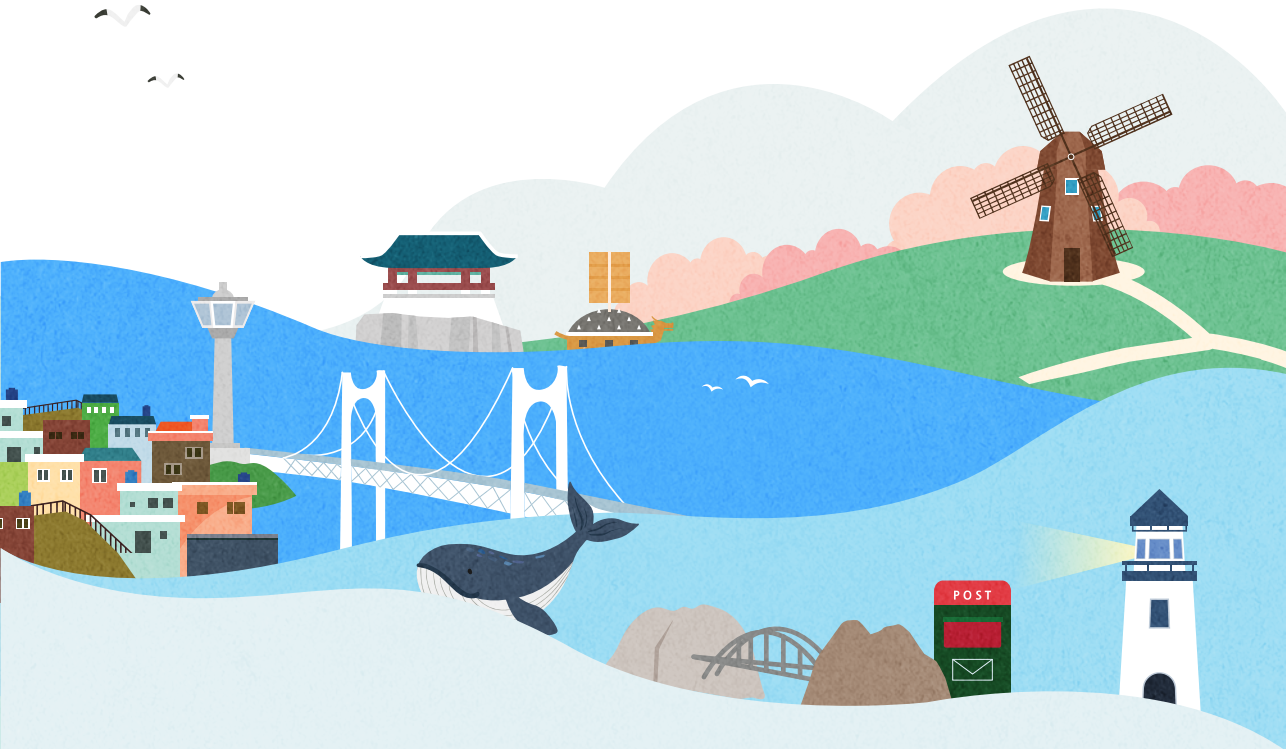
Online competition for representative tourist destinations in the Busan - Gyeongnam Area: 2,541 participants, 5,091 suggested tourist destinations.

## BUSAN



### 1 Huinnyeoul Culture Village

Well-known for being the filming location for various movies including 'The Attorney' and 'Nameless Gangster: Rules of the Time,' and also the spot where the life of refugees began anew. Today, it is famous for beautiful cafes and ateliers.

Take wonderful snapshots at the Songdo Observatory and Huinnyeoul Coastal Tunnel with the gorgeous Yeongdo Sea in the background!

### 2 Taejongdae

Notable for its unfamiliar environment, which includes deep woods, curiously formed rocks, and bizarrely shaped stones that blend with the southern sea, and the panoramic view of the sea from the observatory is breathtaking.

**tip**

If visitors board a cruise ship, they can get up close and personal with the curiously formed rocks and bizarrely shaped stones of Taejongdae while enjoying the refreshing sea breeze!

### 3 Dongbaekseom Island

Notable for the landscape, which combines camellia blooms, pine forests, and the sea. It is enjoyable to take a stroll and see the Nurimaru APEC House and the Dongbaekseom Lighthouse.

**tip** This is a woodland walking route with a sea view that retains the rich natural beauty of camellias and pines!

### 4 Haeundae Beach

Busan's most recognized sight, along with Gwangan Bridge, and because it is a beach in the city center, visitors can enjoy a variety of restaurants and cafes.

**tip** On a yacht, enjoy the stunning sunset and magnificent night scenery in the midst of Haeundae sea!

## 5 Haeundae Beach Train

With this tourist train that has redeveloped the Donghae Nambu Line's historic railway infrastructure for a 4.8km stretch from Haeundae Mipo to Cheongsapo to Songjeong, visitors can experience the wonderful seaside scenery of gorgeous East Busan.

**tip** Take the slow-moving beach train and marvel at the sea's ever-changing splendor!

## 6 Cheongsapo Daritdol Observatory

Enjoy the lovely Cheongsapo coastline landscape, as well as the sunrise and sunset, from the observatory that spans out into the sea. At the end of the observatory, a half-moon shaped transparent floor is built, allowing visitors to experience the amazing sensation of walking on the sea.

**tip** A popular location for sunrise and sunset, and visitors can enjoy a beach full of pebbles rather than sand!

## Recommended Food in Busan



Dwaeji-gukbap

A Busan specialty that combines boiled pork, spices, and salted shrimp in a tasty broth prepared from pork bones.



Nakgopsae

A spicy fried octopus, tripe, and shrimp dish that can be found in Busan.



Jogaeguyi

Clams grilled in their shells over an open flame and enjoyed by dipping in red pepper paste. In Busan, there are several eateries that sell grilled-clams.

## 9 Dongpirang Village

The walls of hundreds of alleyways are adorned with murals, and this fairy-tale-like village that touches the sky has such a vivid landscape that every portion of the village has been utilized as a filming set for various TV series.

## 10 Tongyeong Central Market

A traditional market in the heart of Tongyeong where visitors can sample a variety of fresh and reasonably priced seafood.

Fresh fish collected in the Tongyeong Sea is abundant. For those who like seafood, this is a must-see location!

## 11 DPIRANG

Korea's longest digital theme park that operates at night. Located in the Nangmamsan Mountain, it has 15 themed walkways that employ light and artificial illumination to provide stunning night views.

**tip** If visitors buy a light ball at the ticket office and enter, they can have a fantastic time playing various games!

## 12 Tongyeong Cable Car

The cable car erected on Mireuksan Mountain in Tongyeong is Korea's longest for general visitors. Take in the beautiful view of Hallyeosudo while riding down on a luge, which is a popular activity in Tongyeong.

**tip** From the Skywalk Observatory, visitors can see both the mountains and the sea, as well as Tongyeong!

Seafood

Tongyeong, where the fisheries sector has grown, is brimming with many types of seafood, and visitors can sample fresh seafood as well as diverse seafood-based cuisine.



Chungmu Gimhap

A dish derived from Tongyeong's former name, 'Chungmu', this is gimhap with rice and side dishes served separately, including "kkakdugi" and squid seasoned with vinegar and other condiments.



Tongyeong Honey Bread

This bread is covered with starch syrup and sesame seeds after being fried with red bean paste inside. A unique Tongyeong product.

### 13 Oedo Island

An island in Irun-myeon that is part of the Hally-eohaesang National Park. The entire island is well-known for its picturesque environment evocative of a Mediterranean resort, as well as its popularity as a tourist destination representing Geoje.

## 14 Hill of Wind

A part of Hallyeohaesang National Park, this is a spot where the iconic windmill and the gorgeous beauty of the hill coexist. The wind is strong, as the name implies, and it is located quite near to the Haegeum River.

## 15 Hakdong Mongdol Beach

A Geoje specialty composed with chopped sea squirt and sea urchin blended with rice, sesame oil, and seaweed powder.



**Mulhoe (cold raw fish soup)**

Mulhoe is a seafood dish seasoned with chili peppers and served with cold water. It's a summertime delicacy.



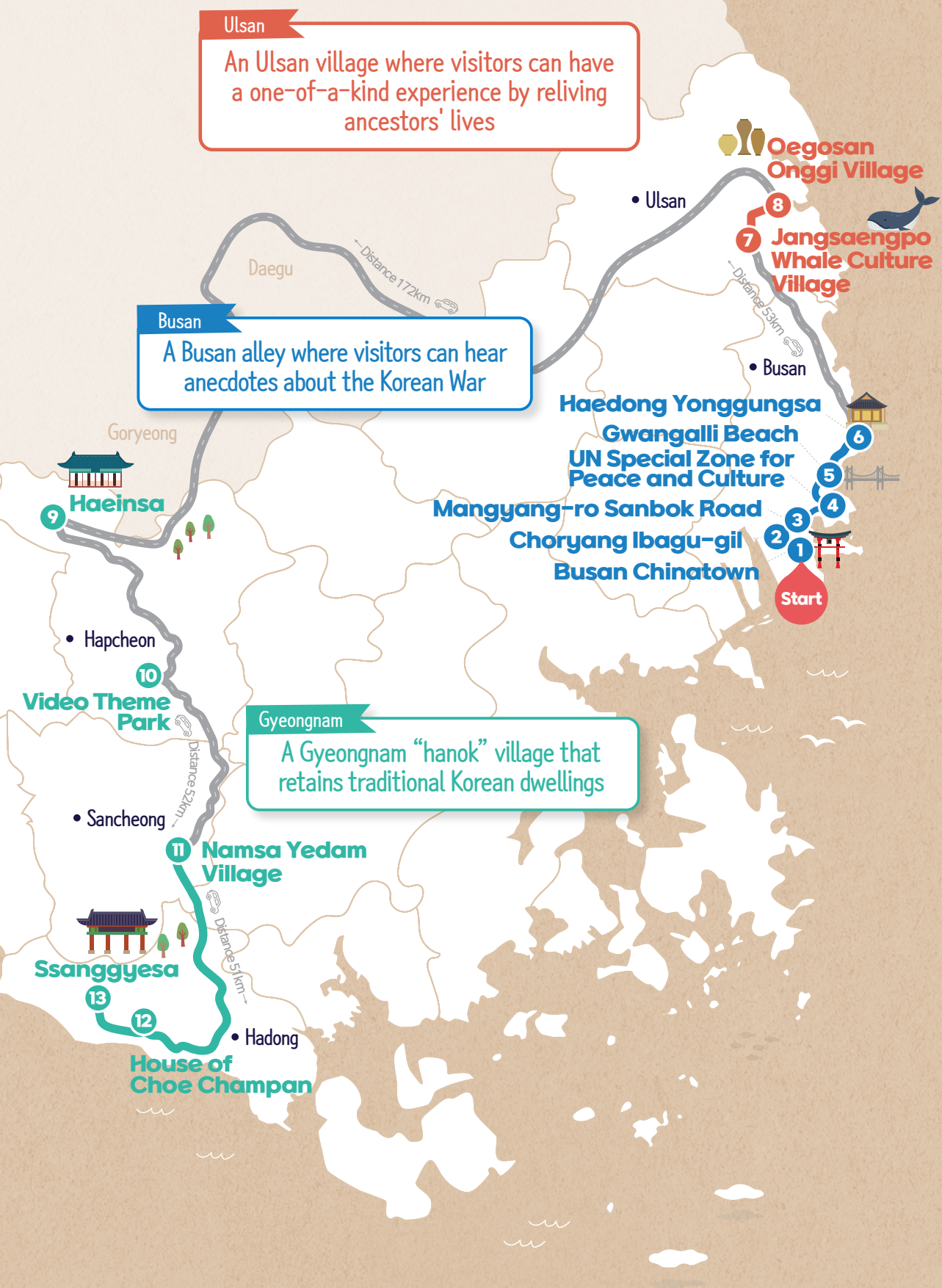
**Hot Dog of the Wind**

### 1 Busan Chinatown

As a major residence for Chinese immigrants, this is a street where visitors can experience Chinese culture. There are many exotic stores and foreigners, and one of the highlights is the Chinatown Special Zone Festival, which is held every October.

### 2 Choryang Ibagu-gil

A themed street with 168 steps that began with the building of Busan Port during the Japanese colonial period, and famed for its monorail.



'Ibagu,' which means 'story' in the Gyeongsang dialect, is an excellent spot to wander around since, as the name suggests, there are many tales that remain in the alleyways!

### ③ Mangyang-ro Sanbok Road

A spot where visitors can look out over the entire city of Busan from the Busan Harbor Bridge, and there are many places to learn about Busan's history, such as Yoo Chi-hwan's mailbox, Yeongju Haneulnoon Observatory, and historical diorama.



Sanbok Road, which tells the stories of Busan's historic and current history, may be explored in comfort using the local bus number 87!

### ④ UN Special Zone for Peace and Culture

The one and only UN military cemetery in the world where UN soldiers who died in the Korean War are memorialized, and there is a park created as an arboretum, so it is a resting place where history, and culture coexist.



There is a lot to see and enjoy at the UN Special Zone for Peace and Culture, including the UN Memorial Park, Peace Park, Sculpture Park, and Daeyeon Arboretum!

## 5 Gwangalli Beach

A beach primarily notable for the Gwangan Bridge, Busan's most recognizable landmark. There are several restaurants and cafés overlooking Gwangan Bridge, which is well-known for its annual fireworks display in October.

**tip** There is a number of workshops around Gwangalli Beach where visitors can enjoy cultural activities through a one-day lesson!

## 6 Haedong Yonggungsa Temple

A floating temple overlooking the open East Sea, and tradition has it that if a visitor touches the nose and belly of the Dharma statue at the top of the stairs, they will conceive a baby boy.

**tip** Yonggungsa Temple is a geological park with a long history of geological heritage formed by nature, so it is great to have a look around there!

A traditional local dish prepared with fish and popular all year round.

A dish produced by combining red pepper paste with pork, popular in Gyeong-sang-do.

A Busan specialty in which noodles are rolled up in broth cooked by boiling the bones of cattle, pigs, and chickens, and served cold.
